Conservatives Expose Gayle Pacheco's Fishy Record

Garden Grove – California Young Americans for Freedom (Cal-YAF) announced that its political action committee, Cal-YAF PAC, has sent a mailer to the Los Angeles County voters in the 60th Assembly District opposing the candidacy of Gayle Pacheco.

The 11 x 17 bi-fold brochure, “There’s Something Fishy About Gayle Pacheco,” questions Pacheco’s claim that she is a conservative.

“Throughout this campaign, Gayle has been trying to position herself as a champion of conservative causes,” said Brandon Powers, Cal-YAF PAC Executive Director. “That claim is fishy and unsubstantiated by her record.”

The mailer, created by 6-time Pollie Award Winner and former Cal-YAF Chairman Jim Bieber of Bieber Communications, details Pacheco’s record of financial mismanagement and wasteful deficit spending.

“With the California economy in shambles, we need every Republican in Sacramento to fight for smaller government and lower taxes,” continued Powers. “With Republicans like Gayle Pacheco, who needs Democrats?”

About Gayle Pacheco, the brochure says, “Her record may look fine at first glance, but why take the chance after you know the facts.” It concludes: “Frankly – Gayle Pacheco’s record stinks.”

Powers added, “After voters are aware of Gayle Pacheco’s record, we’re certain on March 2nd, her campaign will be swimming with the fishes.”

Gayle Pacheco is running for the 60th Assembly District currently held by her husband, Bob. Bob Pacheco is leaving office because of term limits. The district covers portions of Los Angeles, Orange, and San Bernardino Counties and includes portions of Chino Hills, Diamond Bar, Anaheim, La Mirada, Orange, La Habra, Yorba Linda, Walnut, Whittier, Villa Park, La Habra Heights, San Dimas, and Industry.
